**Limited Originality:** Lacks the ability to invent anything original, relying on Srila Prabhupada’s words but distorting them.

**Influence by Mayavadis or Atheists:** Ultimately influenced by mayavadis or atheists, seeking faster fame through alternative paths than Srila Prabhupada’s.

**Unfortunate Influence on Disciples:** Those under the influence of the kanishta adhikari are deemed unfortunate, leading lives filled with gloom and devoid of happiness.

**Corrupted Reflection:** Acts as a bent mirror reflecting Srila Prabhupada, but with corrupted reflecting power, resulting in distorted images or something entirely different for disciples.

**Corrupted Education of Disciples:** Educates and trains disciples in a corrupted understanding of “Krsna Consciousness,” perpetuating the cycle of kanishta adhikaris.

**Selfish Use of Srila Prabhupada’s Movement:** Uses Srila Prabhupada’s movement for personal economic betterment, exploiting it for personal gain.

**Justification of Shortcomings:** If economically incompetent, may define shortcomings as a virtue or detachment.
